



PADI and DPDC eLearning

Do your academic learning on-line, and then complete your confined (pool) sessions and open water dives with a DPDC instructor.

1. You may begin your eLearning through PADI or DPDC website and complete your academics. Just click the eLearning link.
2. You must “affiliate” with a PADI Dive Center to begin. We hope you will affiliate with DPDC.
3. Notify DPDC that you have completed your eLearning. PADI will notify DPDC as well.
4. Schedule and complete your pool sessions and open water dives. The instructor may request that you also complete a 20 question familiarization test.

For your in-water work, we request that you choose to purchase mask, fins, snorkel and soft weights from DPDC. DPDC provides student discounts and student packages for this purpose.

You may also choose to purchase a PADI “enhancement” pack which includes a dive log and your eRDP dive tables.

DPDC Tuition

1. Regular tuition - \$299. Classes may be 1 or 2 individuals.
2. Integrated tuition - \$249. eLearning student may be integrated into an on-going PADI open water class for in-water sessions. Also a group of 3 eLearners comprises an on-going class and pays integrated tuition.

DPDC Tuition includes:

1. Instructor fees
2. Certification card processing
3. Pool fees
4. Use of DPDC wetsuits, BCD’s and regulator sets during in-water sessions.

Tuition does NOT include:

1. Aforementioned mask, fins, snorkel and soft weights
2. Dive fees related to the four open water dives (park entrance fees or boat fees)
3. Any extra pool or open water sessions required due to missed sessions or as may be required by the instructor.
